Identify. Locate. Evaluate.

What is Child Find?

Child find is the process by which districts identify and locate children needing evaluation. All eligible children with disabilities beginning at the age of 3, who are residents of the Banner School District, have a right to a Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE), as mandated by IDEA

All children, **birth to 21**, with disabilities, *or* suspected of having a disability, regardless of the severity of their disability, and who are in need of special education and related services, must be **identified**, **located**, and **evaluated**

What is Child Find?

- Any child birth to 21 with a disability or suspected of having a disability
- Anyone concerned about a child can contact the Child Find representative for additional information and the next steps
- Districts are responsible for finding all students, including those who are homeless.

- If a student qualifies for district special education services, these services are provided at no cost
- Children are evaluated to determine the presence of one or more of the follow disabilities
 - Physical Disability
 - · Deaf or Hard of Hearing
 - Visual Impairment
 - Deaf-Blindness
 - · Intellectual Disability
 - Emotional Disturbance
 - Speech and/or Language
 - Autism
 - Orthopedic Impairment
 - Other Health Impairment
 - · Traumatic Brain Injury
 - · Specific Learning Disability
